\$50,000 REWARD

On Monday February 8th, 2010 at approximately 1800hrs Tyrell DUFFUS told his girlfriend that he was returning to their apartment at 20 Falstaff Avenue to take care of something.

Sometime around 1830hrs Mr. Duffus was drawn to the eighth floor stairwell of this apartment building where it appears he became involved in a conversation with an unknown person or persons. It was at this time that a firearm was produced and Mr. Duffus was shot several times.

At approximately 2230hr, approximately four hours later an occupant of one of the apartments on the eighth floor walked out of his apartment and entered the stairwell where he located Mr. Duffus laying on the floor.

Mr. Duffus was pronounced dead at the scene.

I am authorizing a reward of **fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00)** from the Toronto Police Service for evidence leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for this murder.

This reward is restricted only to those persons who have not previously provided a statement to the Toronto Police Service pertaining to this investigation. In addition employees and/or volunteer staff and their immediate family members of Law Enforcement and Correctional Agencies are not eligible to collect this reward.

The reward is payable in Canadian funds and expires on March 23, 2011 and shall be apportioned as the Toronto Police Service deems just. Claims will be recognized only when made in writing prior to the expiry date.
