WHO WE ARE

We are a committee of representatives from the community, local businesses, schools, youth and police officers from 41 Division. Our mandate is to have meaningful community partnerships with Toronto Police Service to help build community capacity, to be resources to police and community, as well as to be active in community relationships and crime prevention.

WHAT IS THE CPLC SCHOLARSHIP?

The 41 Division CPLC scholarship is a new program launching in 2023. It is being created to recognize financial needs of students and support students attending post-secondary school programs. 41 Division CPLC scholarship would like to recognize students who have been active participants and have contributed to their communities.

\$1000 will be awarded to each student.

WHO CAN APPLY?

You must meet all of the following criteria:

- The students must reside in the geographical area of 41 Division. The boundaries are:
 - On the East - Brimley Road
 - On the South - Lake Ontario
 - On the West - Victoria Park Avenue
 - On the North - HWY 401
- Must be a student graduating in 2022/2023
- Enrolled to start a full time post-secondary program in 2023
- Have demonstrated commitment to co-curricular activities and community service.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Complete the attached application form and submit the application and all the required documents by May 31st, 2023. Completed applications are to be sent via mail or dropped off at 41 Division.
