- → Commercial vehicles may be exempt from a seven-day impoundment under HTA S. 55.2 if the driver's licence has been suspended for less than 100 days <u>and</u> the vehicle's registered gross weight is more than 4,500 kg.

*If TSV personnel advise that SIMS is not available, complete the Notice to Registrar and/or Notice of Suspension without an impoundment or suspension number, serve a copy on the driver and fax to the MTO at prior to reporting off duty.

** <u>Novice/Young Drivers</u> / <u>Commercial Drivers</u> - Medical cannabis users may be exempted from zero tolerance sanctions if a police officer is satisfied that they are legally authorized to use drugs for medical purposes; however, these drivers can still face penalties or criminal charges if a police officer determines that their ability to drive has been impaired.

Reportable suspensions and impoundments shall be reported to MTO as soon as possible and prior to reporting off duty.

Confiscated driver's licence cards (including out-of-province cards) <u>must</u> be forwarded via internal mail to the attention of the TSV-MTO Liaison Officer for disposition.
